A. Consider minutes from February 13, 2019 meeting

C. Discussion on themed Art Exhibits for upcoming year i.e. Pride, Black History

Staff put forth the idea of themed art exhibits due to recent request to have exhibits for Black History Month and PRIDE. There was a discussion regarding having the curator come to at least 4 meetings per year to discuss upcoming exhibits. Curating themed shows maybe more difficult than it seems.

Dan Mayer discussed hiring a consultant to conduct this type of study and state he would reach out to Jeff York to come to a committee meeting to discuss.
